Important information about the registration:

After registration, you (or your child) will receive an e-mail to create a KNVB account. You will then need to add a photo to your (or your child's) account. Without a photo, no valid player pass can be created and you (or your child) are not eligible to play. This applies to all indoor and field football players of the Under 13 age category and parents. All players born on or after 1 January 1998 are obliged by the KNVB to obtain the game rules certificate. You (or your child) will receive an e-mail about this after registration.

CONFIDENTIAL CONTACT PERSON

Are you dealing with sexual harassment or other undesirable behavior and do you want to talk to someone about it? FC Kraggenburg has appointed two confidential contact persons (VCP) to have a first point of contact for its members.

The VCP is familiar with the possibilities of getting help and can advise and/or refer you about this and has also received training for this through NOC*NSF.

In this way, the VCP serves as the first shelter for members. The VCP also advises the association on preventive measures.

Not only the person who has been affected by undesirable behaviour can contact the VCP, but an accused also has the option of asking the VCP for a referral to the good advice. Do you suspect undesirable behaviour in someone close to you? Then you can also contact the confidential contact persons and discuss the possibilities for help.
